

In response to the COVID-19 outbreak, Congress appropriated emergency supplemental funds to rapidly establish and monitor key activities in the areas of epidemiology, laboratory, and informatics. This funding is to enhance existing workforce availability to implement data modernization efforts, including core data modernization infrastructure, implementation of electronic case reporting (eCR), and modernization of the National Vital Statistics System to move towards faster, more automated sharing of vital statistics between the state and national levels. This funding will support several positions to improve workforce capacity and lead/implement data modernization efforts at the Arkansas Department of Health(ADH); enhance/expand eCR to ADH; and lead FHIR API conversion efforts with the National Vital Statistics System.
