 The Partnership Grant is designed to affirmatively further fair housing statewide by implementing a "Four Corners Fair Housing/ Fair Lending Education/Outreach Tour" to gather information on statewide fair housing/fair lending issues and to educate the populous on statewide efforts and provide tangible information on housing issues. AFHC will educate home-owners, home-seekers, housing providers and the general public on rights and responsibilities associated with Title VIII; educate the populous on fair housing and fair lending from a broad range perspective; engage municipalities, policy makers and housing providers in discussions on how to better promote housing opportunities statewide; and provide technical information on HUD's new Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing rule affecting municipalities and the state as a whole. Additionally, the grant will be used to design and implement a Database to collect and house fair housing/fair lending statistical data.




