Discussion of ATF Raid on Bryan Malinowski's Home

Mark Bowling (Retired), Chief Risk Security Officer, Federal Bureau of Investigation; Colonel Mike Hagar, Director of Arkansas State Police (ASP) and Secretary, Department of Public Safety (DPS); Hugh Finkelstein, Chief of Staff, DPS; Major Stacie Rhoads, Commander, Criminal Investigation Division, ASP; and Heath Helton, Chief, Little Rock Police Department; provided details regarding their agencies' involvement in the raid of Bryan Malinowski's home by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms (ATF) on March 19, 2024.

Senator Clark made a motion that authority be granted to the chair of the Senate Committee on Judiciary to exercise the subpoena power of the committee to issue subpoenas for persons, documents, and records related to the ATF raid of the home of Bryan Malinowski on March 19, 2024, seconded by Senator Rice, and the motion carried.
