28	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-9-521(g), concerning an employee
29	suffering a scheduled injury under the Workers' Compensation Law, is amended
30	to read as follows:
31	(g) A ny employee suffering a scheduled injury shall not be entitled to
32	permanent partial disability benefits in excess of the percentage of
33	permanent physical impairment set forth above except as otherwise provided in
34	<u>§ 11-9-519(b)</u> In considering a claim for permanent partial disability
35	benefits in excess of the employee's percentage of permanent physical
36	impairment, the Workers' Compensation Commission may take into account, in

1	addition to the percentage of permanent physical impairment, such factors as
2	the employee's age, education, work experience, and other matters reasonably
3	expected to affect his or her future earning capacity.
