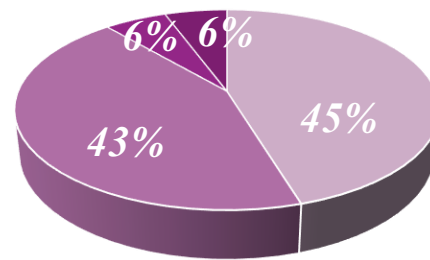

Residency Graduate Impact

- AHEC Southwest opened in Texarkana in 1976
- UAMS Southwest Family Medicine Clinic opened in 1993
- 194 confirmed resident graduates to date
- 8-8-8 residency program, filling all approved residency slots, with 8 residents graduating in 2025

Pipeline Programs

82 Students directly supported through advising and programs (Find Your Future in Healthcare, MASH, One-on-One Advising, Pre-College Sessions, Shadowing Events)

12,796 Students reached through statewide collaborative efforts (Health and Medical Career Fairs, Health Profession Presentations, Community Outreach)
