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34	23-88-601. Purpose.
35	The purpose of this subchapter is to ensure that licensed family
36	childcare homes in Arkansas are protected from the termination or nonrenewal

1	of homeowners insurance based solely on their operation as licensed family
2	<pre>childcare homes.</pre>
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4	23-88-602. Definitions.
5	As used in this subchapter:
6	(1) "Homeowners insurance policy" means a type of property
7	insurance policy that provides financial protection against certain risks
8	associated with homeownership;
9	(2) "Licensed family childcare home" means a residence licensed
10	by the Department of Education to provide childcare services to a specified
11	number of children;
12	(3) "Personal liability insurance policy" means an insurance
13	policy that provides coverage for claims made against the insured for bodily
14	injury or property damage caused by the insured's negligence; and
15	(4) "Separate personal liability insurance policy" means an
16	insurance policy that provides a minimum coverage of one hundred thousand
17	dollars (\$100,000) per occurrence specifically for liabilities arising from
18	operation of a licensed family childcare home.

20	23-88-603. Protection from insurance cancellations — Discrimination
21	against licensed family childcare homes prohibited — Minimum personal
22	liability insurance required.
23	(a) A homeowners insurance provider shall not:
24	(1) Cancel or refuse to renew a homeowners insurance policy of a
25	licensed family childcare home based solely on the operation of a licensed
26	family childcare home if the licensed family childcare home meets or exceeds
27	all applicable rules of the Department of Education; or
28	(2) Charge rates that exceed the rate amount of a homeowners
29	insurance policy with the same square footage or value.
30	(b) An operator of a licensed family childcare home shall maintain a
31	separate personal liability insurance policy with a minimum coverage amount
32	of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) per occurrence in addition to the
33	operator's homeowners insurance policy.
34	(c) A homeowners insurance provider shall provide:
35	(1) Written notice to a licensed family childcare home of any
36	reason for potential cancellation of the homeowners insurance policy or

1	nonrenewal of the homeowners insurance policy; and
2	(2) An opportunity for an operator of a licensed family
3	childcare home to remedy the situation that resulted in the potential
4	cancellation of the homeowners insurance policy or nonrenewal of the

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8	23-88-604. Responsibilities of operators of licensed family childcare
9	homes.
10	(a) An operator of a licensed family childcare home shall submit proof
11	of the operator's separate personal liability insurance policy to the
12	operator's homeowners insurance provider annually or upon renewal of the
13	operator's homeowners insurance policy.
14	(b) An operator of a licensed family childcare home shall comply with
15	all local and state rules and federal regulations regarding the operation of
16	a licensed family childcare home to remain eligible for the protections
17	described in this subchapter.
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19	<u>23-88-605. Enforcement.</u>
20	(a)(1) The Department of Education shall enforce this subchapter.
21	(2) The Department of Education shall promulgate rules to
22	implement and administer this subchapter.
23	(b)(1) An operator of a licensed childcare facility may file a
24	complaint with the Department of Education if the operator believes the
25	operator's homeowners insurance provider has violated this subchapter.
26	(2) If an operator of a licensed childcare facility files a
27	complaint with the Department of Education under subdivision (b)(1) of this
28	section shall make a referral to the State Insurance Department.
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30	<u>23-88-606. Severability.</u>
31	If any provision of this subchapter is found to be unconstitutional or
32	otherwise invalid, the remaining provisions shall continue in effect.
