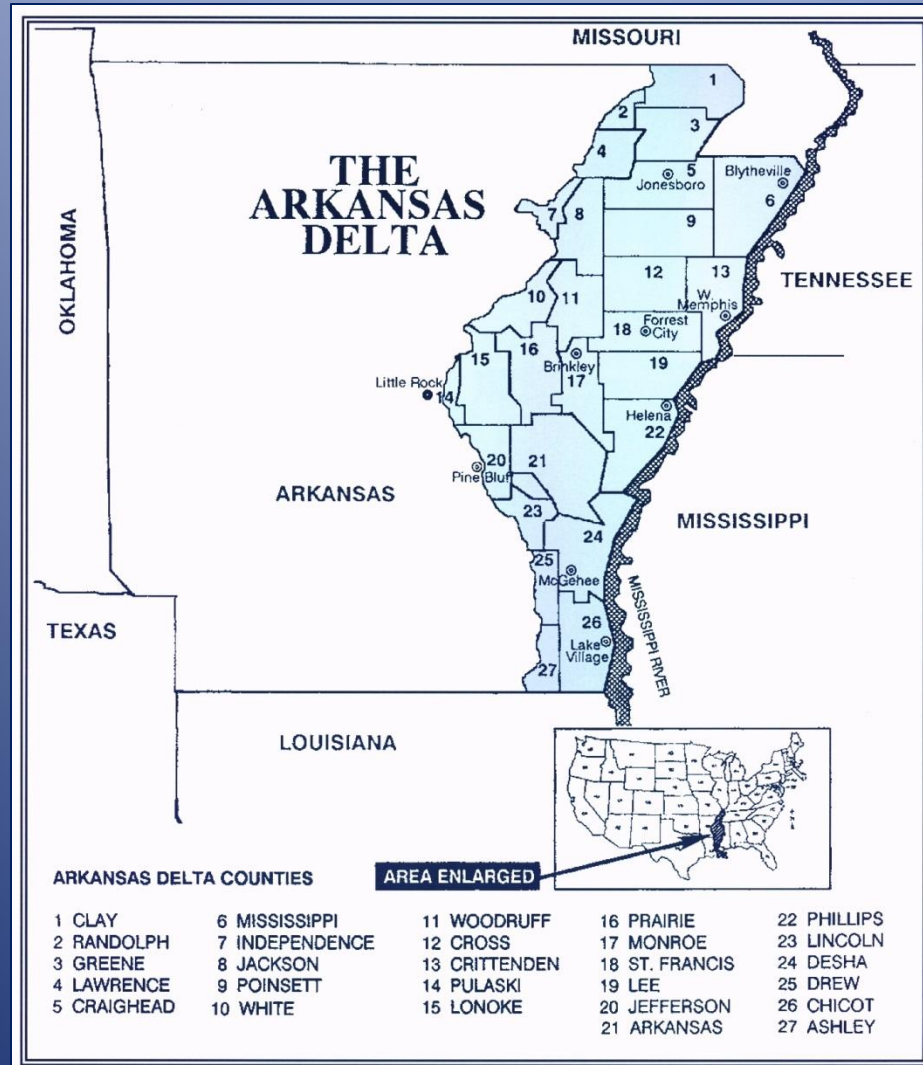
DCC 101

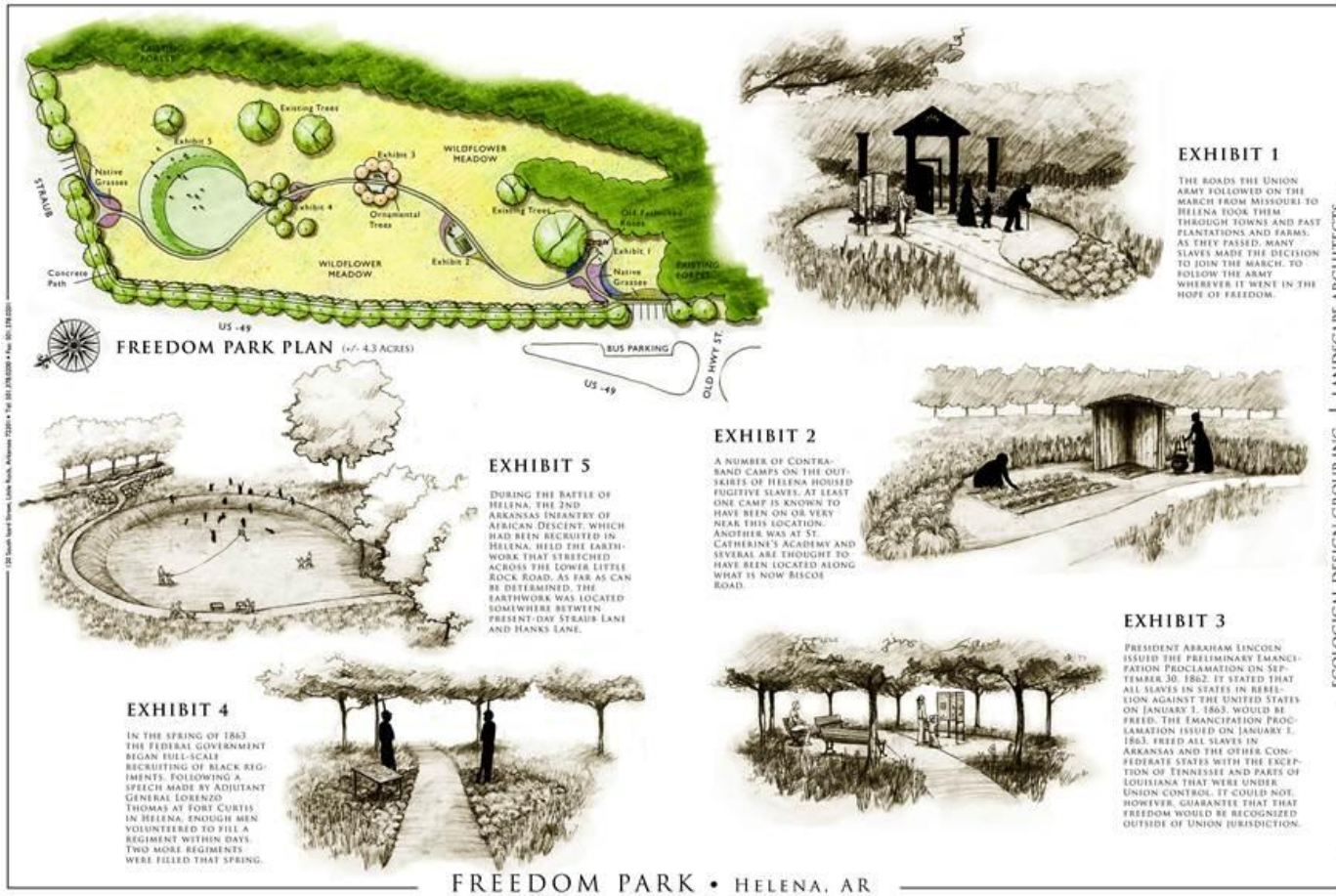
