Brian Meadors is an Arkansas native, experienced nuclear lawyer, registered Professional Engineer (nuclear), and former U.S. Navy Nuclear Submarine Officer.

Brian earned his B.S.E. in nuclear engineering from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, in 1991. The Navy commissioned Brian as an officer serving aboard nuclear submarines engaging in classified missions. The Navy awarded Brian the Navy Expeditionary Medal for special operations, and two awards of the Navy Achievement Medal for engineering and management excellence.



After the Navy, Brian earned his law degree, *cum laude*, from Georgetown University. Brian worked several years as a nuclear attorney in the law firm Morgan Lewis's energy section and then returned home to Arkansas where he spent a decade as a jury trial lawyer, appearing in hundreds of cases before judges, juries, and various administrative bodies.

When the Vogtle nuclear projects began, Brian joined Southern Company, leading a licensing team on the Vogtle 3 & 4 AP1000 new reactors. He represented Southern Company before the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Department of Energy, and Congressional Staff.

After Southern, Brian served as General Electric's nuclear regulatory counsel and employee concerns manager until joining NuScale Power as its Chief Licensing Engineer. At NuScale, Brian took the lead on licensing innovation and strategies. He wrote and taught NuScale's comprehensive training program for licensing engineers; the program includes licensing, writing, and advanced advocacy skills.

Brian is now part of EXCEL's executive management team, acting as General Counsel, Executive Vice President of Legislative Initiatives, an innovator of services, business developer, and project manager.
