High-Growth School Districts

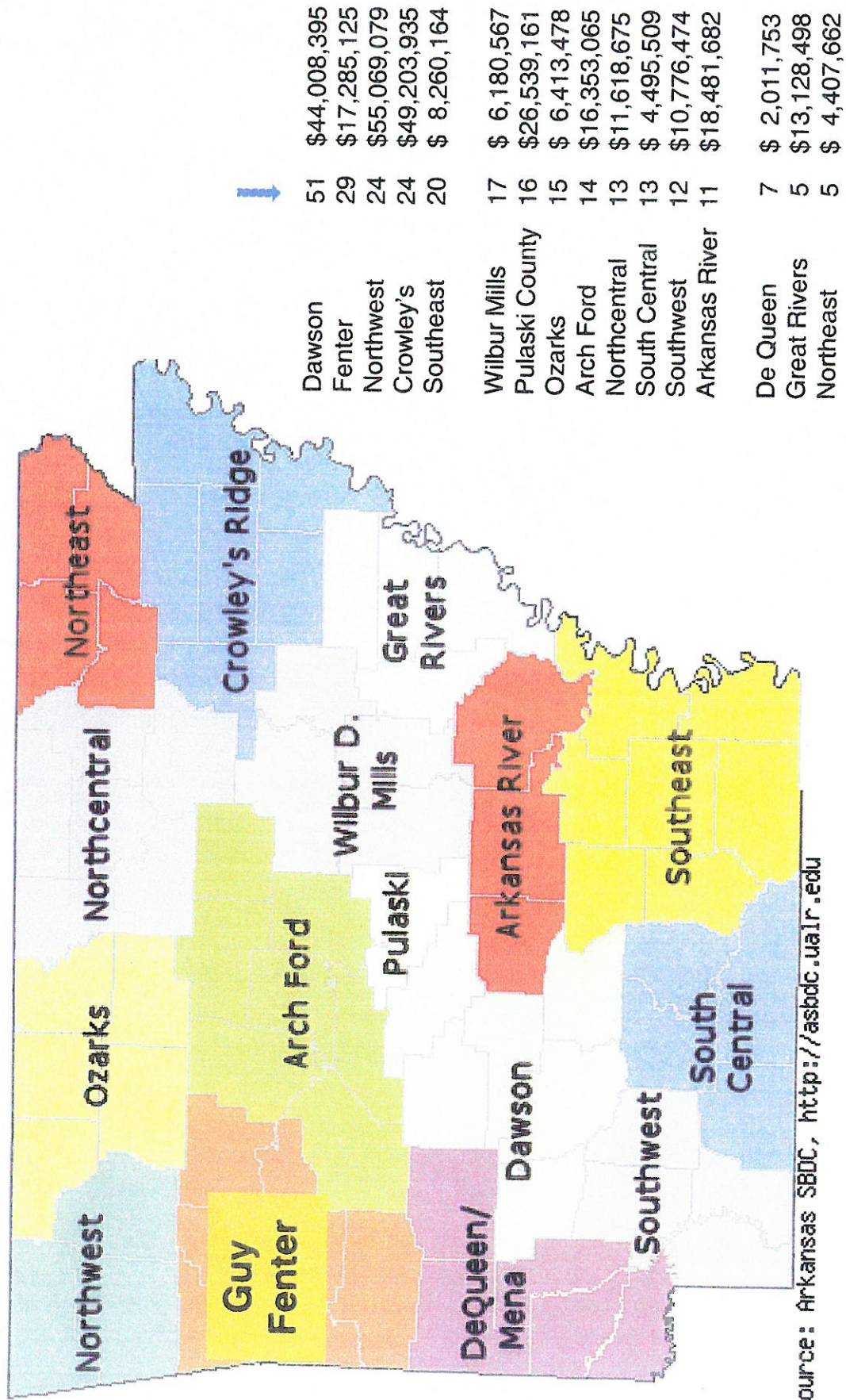
The Commission shall annually determine which school districts qualify as high-growth school districts under this section.

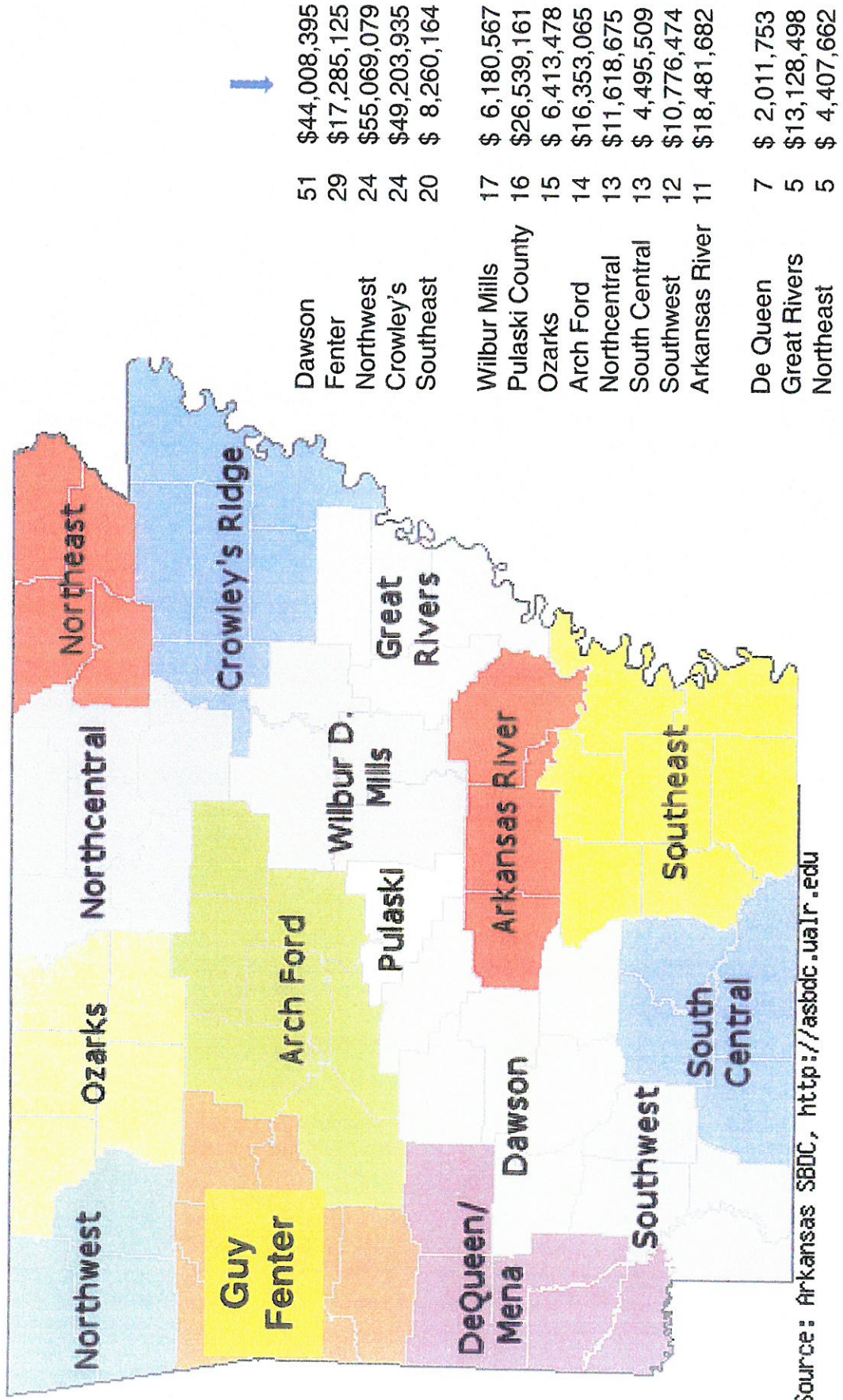
