**PREVALENCE OF CHILD MALTREATMENT\***

**NATIONALLY,**

**6,951,000 CHILDREN WERE VICTIMS OF CHILD MALTREATMENT.**

- Neglect: 78.3%
- Physical Abuse: 17.6%
- Sexual Abuse: 9.2%

**IN ARKANSAS,**

**11,729 CHILDREN WERE VICTIMS OF CHILD MALTREATMENT.**

- Neglect: 68.7%
- Physical Abuse: 20.3%
- Sexual Abuse: 20.7%

**ARKANSAS CAC'S**

**INTERVIEWED 3,689 CHILDREN DURING FY 2012.**

**AR BEST TRAINING**

- **490** clinicians from 59 counties have completed the Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) workshop
- **139** providers have completed follow-up consultation calls and received certificates in TF-CBT
- **98** clinicians are participating in the third round of TF-CBT consultation calls

**490** MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS HAVE COMPLETED THE TF-CBT TWO-DAY TRAINING

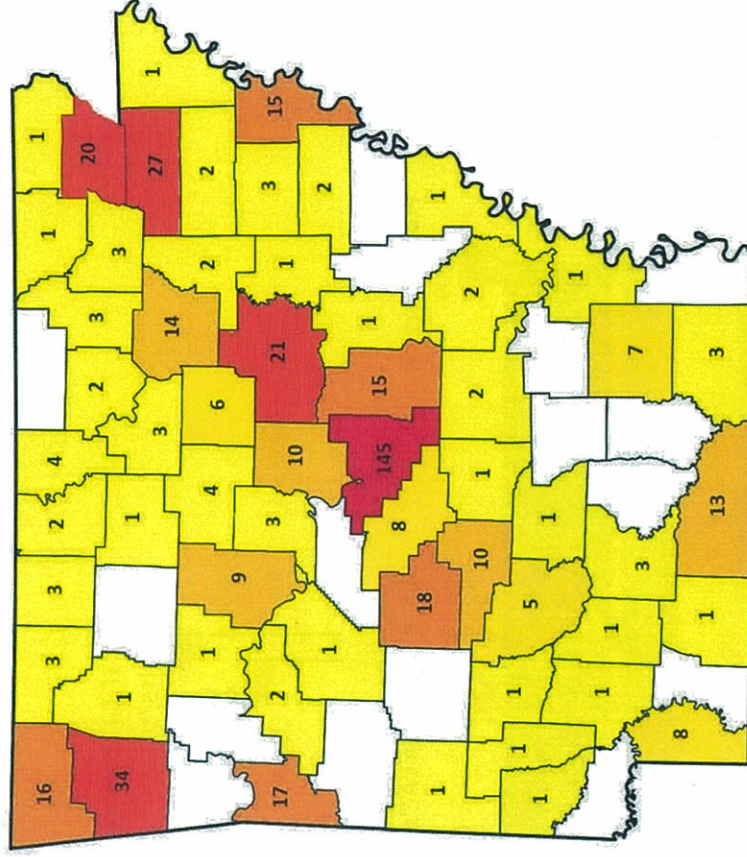
