HOUSE BILL 1099

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR IMMUNITY OF LEGAL PERSONNEL FROM
MALPRACTICE SUITS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Immunity of legal personnel from malpractice suits.

No attorney, judge advocate, legal officer, legal clerk or other supporting personnel of the Arkansas National Guard shall be liable for damages for personal injury or loss caused by negligence or wrongful acts or omissions of any such attorney, judge advocate, legal officer, legal clerk or other supporting personnel while acting within the scope of her duties as a member of the Arkansas National Guard.

SECTION 2. Any person seeking damages therefor shall seek the remedies provided against the United States by Sections 1346(b) and 2671 through 2680 of Title 28 of the United States Code if the cause of action arose while such legal personnel was performing military duty pursuant to Title 32 or Title 10 to the United States Code or by filing a claim against the State of Arkansas if the alleged acts or omissions were performed by members of the Arkansas National Guard while performing active state duty.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
