HOUSE BILL 1675

"AN ACT TO REDUCE EXPENDITURES OF THE ELECTED CONSTITUTIONAL
OFFICERS FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1989; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. For the biennial period beginning July 1, 1987, and ending June 30, 1989, the following restrictions shall apply:

A. The amount of Public Relations Expenses for which eligible Executive Branch elected constitutional officers are authorized to receive by law is hereby reduced by twenty five percent (25%);

B. The amount of per diem for which members of the General Assembly may receive for attending legislative functions during the interim shall be reduced by ten dollars (\$10) from that for which such members were eligible to receive during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987;

C. Any housing allowance or transportation allowance authorized for any elected constitutional officer for the biennial period beginning July 1, 1987, and ending June 30, 1989, shall be reduced by ten percent (10%);

D. The amount of expenses for which a Circuit Judge, Chancery Judge, Circuit/Chancery Judge, or Prosecuting Attorney may receive or may be reimbursed from state funds shall be reduced by ten percent (10%);

E. An amount equal to five percent (5%) of each appropriation made by the 76th General Assembly for personal services and operating expenses for the offices and employees of the elected constitutional officers shall be deferred by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State each year and shall not be made available for disbursement or obligation.
