HOUSE BILL 1678

"AN ACT TO CONSERVE STATE TAX REVENUES BY COMBINING THE LAW SCHOOLS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT FAYETTEVILLE AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK INTO ONE LAW SCHOOL TO BE LOCATED IN LITTLE ROCK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In order to eliminate duplication of effort and to provide revenue savings to the taxpayers of this State, the Board of trustees of the University of Arkansas System shall consolidate the Fayetteville Law School and the Little Rock Law School into a single law school to be located in Little Rock, by no later than the end of the 1988 school year.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
