HOUSE BILL 1992

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF ACT 429 OF 1955, AS AMENDED
[ARK. STATS. 14-421.1] TO PRESCRIBE THE CHARGE TO BE MADE BY
THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ARKANSAS SUPREME COURT
REPORTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Act 429 of 1955, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes 14-421.1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. The Secretary of State shall sell each volume of the Arkansas Supreme Court Reports for an amount equal to the cost of the volume plus postage costs."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that it is immediately necessary that the price to be charged by the Secretary of State for volumes of the Arkansas Supreme Court Reports must be increased to enable the State to recover the costs of printing and binding of the volumes and the postage cost for mailing; that this Act is designed to accomplish this purpose and should be given effect immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
