HOUSE BILL 2047

"AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 327 OF 1941, AS AMENDED, TO PROVIDE FOR MORE COST EFFECTIVE SCHOOL MANAGEMENT; TO REPEAL SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 6 AND 7 OF ACT 146 OF 1949; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Sections 13 through 18 of Act 327 of 1941, as amended, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-217 through 80-220, and 80-225, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Section 8 of Act 327 of 1941, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-210, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. The County Board of Education shall elect one of its members chairman and one of its members secretary of the board."

SECTION 3. Section 10 of Act 327 of 1941, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-212, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 10. The County Board of Education shall meet on the call of the chairman, on the call of any three (3) members of the board, or at any such time as business is pending before the board."

SECTION 4. Section 12 of Act 327 of 1941, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-215, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 12. The secretary of each County Board of education shall keep a record of all meetings and all business transactions of the County Board and together with the chairman, sign the record at the close of each business meeting. The Secretary shall keep a permanent copy of the record and file a copy thereof with the County Clerk."

SECTION 5. Section 1 of Act 159 of 1957, as amended, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-235, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. (a) School districts within a county may elect to employ a secretary or a supervisor. In the event such an election is made, the secretary or supervisor obtains any authority, duties or responsibilities as a result of the employment, having no statutory authority, duties or responsibilities.

(b) The salary of a secretary or supervisor employed by the districts shall be paid by the districts from their MFPA funds, State apportionment, or from other local resources."

SECTION 6. Sections 1, 2, 3, 6 and 7 of Act 146 of 1949, as amended, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-229 through 80-231, 80-233, and 80-234 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. Section 4 of Act 146 of 1949, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. 80-232 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. The County Judge, County Clerk and the Secretary of the County Board shall rezone the county into the appropriate number of zones, according to law, when requested to do so by resolution of the County Board of Education. Such rezoning shall not take place more often than once every four years and must divide the county into zones in an equitable manner. Maps of the rezoned county shall be made, posted and published in the local newspapers.

SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
