HOUSE BILL2050

"AN ACT TO SET MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR TIME SERVED FOR
PERSONS SENTENCED TO LIFE IMPRISONMENT; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Individuals who are under sentence of, or who are sentenced to, life imprisonment shall not be eligible for parole unless such sentence is commuted to a term of less than sixty (60) years by executive clemency, or until such time as they have served the minimum time prescribed in this Act, with credit for good time allowances, based upon a life sentence being equivalent to a sentence of a sixty (60) term of years. The minimum time prescribed shall be based upon classification as a first, second, third, or fourth offender as those terms are defined in Section 2 of Act 825 of 1983.
