HOUSE BILL 2052

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING TITLE IN
ARKANSAS TO A MOTOR VEHICLE WHEN THE OWNER OF THE MOTOR
VEHICLE IS UNKNOWN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. When any person petitions the chancery court for an order directing the Department of Finance and Administration to issue a certificate of registration for a motor vehicle, the court shall not issue such order unless the Department of Finance and Administration certifies to the court that the National Crime Information Center does not list the motor vehicle as being stolen. Furthermore, in such instance the Arkansas State Police shall, if requested, provide the party petitioning the court or the Department of Finance and Administration a printout from the National Crime Information Center which is the subject matter of any petition to chancery court for title to a motor vehicle. The State Police must provide such printout within five days of the date of request from the individual seeking issuance of title or the Department of Finance and Administration.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
