"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ACT 162 OF 1967 TO INCLUDE
EMPLOYEES OF STATE AGENCIES IN THE DEFINITION OF LOBBYIST;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 162 of 1967, the same being Arkansas Statute 4-801, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. As used in this Act, a 'lobbyist' is hereby defined to be any person, including a member of the General Assembly who is paid by any non-governmental group, who by his acts, as a representative of any recognized group or organization, state agency, department, board or commission or who for compensation or as an employee of a state agency, department, board or commission, seeks to influence in any manner, the vote of any member or members of the House or Senate, or the actions of any of the Committees of the House or Senate, upon any bill, resolution or other measure pending before the House or Senate, or any of the Committees thereof.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
