HOUSE BILL 2054

"AN ACT TO RECOGNIZE THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE'S
ROLE IN THE DETERMINATION OF SALARIES, HOURS AND WORKING
CONDITIONS AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE REASONABLE AND ORDERLY
RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES BETWEEN EMPLOYERS AND THE PUBLIC
SCHOOL TEACHERS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Short Title. This Act may be cited as the "Arkansas Public
School Employees Negotiation Act".

SECTION 2. Policy. It is the declared policy of the State of Arkansas

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES DIVISION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Developmental Disabilities Services Division, to be payable from the Department of Human Services Federal Funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses and purchase of service grants of the Department of Human Services - Developmental Disabilities Services Division for the biennial period ending June 30, 1989, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
