SENATE BILL 635

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS STATUTE 3-609 TO DESCRIBE THE
FORMULA FOR DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF ELECTION EXPENSES TO
BE BORNE BY MUNICIPALITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9 of Article 6 of Act 465 of 1969, the same being Arkansas Statute 3-609, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. All expenses for general or special elections for presidential, congressional, State, district, county, township or municipal offices in this State shall be paid by the Counties in which they are held; provided, however, that any city or incorporated town shall reimburse the County Election Commission for the expenses of any election in an amount equal to a figure derived by dividing the total cost of the election by the total number of election precincts in the county, and that figure divided by the total number of positions on the precinct ballot, and that number multiplied by the number of city questions and positions on the precinct ballot, and that number multiplied by the number of precincts in the city."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
