SENATE BILL 658

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT PERSONS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR WHEN OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE OR RIDING ON A MOTORCYCLE AS A PASSENGER."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, persons eighteen years of age and older shall not be required to wear protective headgear when operating motorcycles or motor-driven cycles or when passengers on motorcycles or motor-driven cycles.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
