9 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE TO CONFORM  
10 REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR TRAILERS WITH THE THREE  
11 YEAR REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR PERMANENT TRAILER TAGS;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 CONFORMS REGISTRATION PROCEDURES FOR  
15 TRAILERS WITH THE NOTICE PERIOD FOR  
16 OTHER VEHICLES AND THE THREE YEAR  
17 REGISTRATION PERIOD FOR TRAILERS.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-14-1206(b) pertaining to the registration  
24 of trailers is amended to read as follows:

25 (b) ~~Forty five (45)~~ Thirty (30) days before the expiration of the  
26 license, the director shall notify the owner of a registered trailer subject  
27 to this subchapter at the last address of the owner of the trailer as the  
28 owner's name and address appear on the records of the office, but the director  
29 is not required to go beyond the face of the last registration statement.  
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31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-1210(a) pertaining to the registration  
32 of trailers is amended to read as follows:

33 (a) The owner of every trailer of a type subject to the provisions of  
34 this subchapter, upon registration, shall receive a permanent license plate  
35 issued by the director upon the payment of a ~~biennial~~ triennial fee based upon  
36 the annual fee as set forth in § 27-14-601.

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SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-14-1214(b) pertaining to the registration of trailers is amended to read as follows:

(b) The applicant, upon receiving notification by the director of his new permanent registration date, shall, within the time prescribed by the director, pay a ~~twelve-month~~ thirty-six-month registration fee.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 27-14-1215 pertaining to the registration of trailers is amended to read as follows:

27-14-1215. Issuance of ~~biennial~~ triennial tab.

(a) In conjunction with the permanent license plate, the director shall issue a tab or decal ~~biennially~~ triennially, or when appropriate, to each qualified applicant as evidence of the ~~biennial~~ triennial payment of license fees.

(b) The trailer owner shall affix and display the tab or decal in such place as the director shall designate.
