17 NOW THEREFORE,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
19 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

21 That the General Assembly urges Congress to expand the Medical Savings
22 Account Act to include:

- 23 (1) Opening medical savings accounts to all small businesses;
24 (2) Self-employed persons;
25 (3) Unemployed persons;
26 (4) The payment of insurance premiums as an allowable cost;
27 (5) Contributions from both employer and employee allowed; and
28 (6) No limit as to contribution from employee or employer.
