17 STUDY OF LONG-TERM DRUG TREATMENT OF

19 METHAMPHETAMINE OR CRACK COCAINE.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL
22 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 That the House and Senate Interim Committees on Judiciary are requested
25 to conduct a study concerning long-term drug treatment of criminal offenders
26 who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack cocaine.
27

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Community
29 Punishment is requested to file a report with the committees by September 1,
30 2001, concerning the department's programs to provide long-term drug
31 treatment of criminal offenders who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack
32 cocaine. The report should include:

- 33 (1) A description of the drug treatment program and options used
34 by the department;
35 (2) A list of the facilities used in the treatment program;
36 (3) The number of offenders in each facility who are

1 participating in the long-term treatment program;
2 (4) The number and categories of treatment staff utilized by the
3 program;
4 (5) The average length of treatment;
5 (6) The recidivism rate; and
6 (7) Any recommendations to improve the department's drug
7 treatment of criminal offenders who are addicted to methamphetamine or crack
8 cocaine.
