10 BUILDING INFRASTRUCTURE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF

18 AND ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES
19 DIVISION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE PROGRAM. There is
26 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
27 Revenue Services Division, to be payable from the Commercial Driver License
28 Fund, for Ledbetter Building Infrastructure of the Department of Finance and
29 Administration - Revenue Services Division which shall be supplemental and in
30 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 5 of Act 730 of 2001, the
31 following:

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3 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION-MARKETING AND REDISTRIBUTION. There is hereby
4 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Managements
5 Services Division - Marketing and Redistribution, to be payable from the
6 Property Sales Holding Fund, which shall be supplemental and in addition to
7 those funds appropriated in Section 14 of Act 120 of 2001, the following:

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13 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
16 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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23 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
30 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
33 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
34 the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division are,
35 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance
36 and Administration - Revenue Services Division to continue to provide

1 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
2 the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
3 Revenue Services Division to continue such services; and that a delay in the
4 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
5 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
6 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
7 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
8 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

9 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
10 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
11 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
12 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
13 the veto.
