35 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CLAIMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the 36 Arkansas State Claims Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous

1 Revolving Fund, for payment of claims awarded to surviving spouses and/or 2 dependent children of deceased policemen, firemen, correctional officers and other specified state employees killed in the official line of duty, as 3 4 prescribed by law; for payment of small controversial claim awards made by 5 the Arkansas State Claims Commission; and for payment of awards made by the 6 Arkansas State Claims Commission, as provided by law, on non-controversial 7 claims, for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

With the exception of death and disability benefit 17 claims paid under the provisions of §§ 21-5-701 - 21-5-707, no award may be paid in excess of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500) ten thousand 18 19 dollars (\$10,000). SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission 25 26 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act 27 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment 28 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an 29 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 30 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due 31 32 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through 33 the State Mechanized Payroll System. 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

1 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 3 4 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19

SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 20 21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 25 26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 31 32 33 34 35
