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SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 30 PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 31 Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No. (08) 32 Summer Projects, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item No. 33 (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate Teachers, Houseparents, Food 34 Service, Nursing staff who work during the summer months on summer projects, 35 and to cover other expenses of summer project activities and to compensate 36 coaches and organization sponsors as referenced in Section 9 of this Act.

- 1 Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum
- 2 salary authorized for said employees.

- 6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 8 ALLOWANCE. The Arkansas Schools for the Deaf and Blind may make special
- 9 allowances available to any employee who performs one of the following duties

- 1) Teaching adult education classes on weekends or evenings
- 12 2) Coaching one or more sports
- 3) Sponsoring a club or organization that involves additional hours

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- 22 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 24 ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or
- 25 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind
- 26 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other
- 27 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other
- 28 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's
- 29 written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 30 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not
- 31 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary
- 32 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not
- 33 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the

- 8 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED 9 10 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the State Treasurer are 11 authorized to establish a joint paying account in the State Treasury, upon 12 direction of the Board of Trustees for the Arkansas School for the Blind and the Arkansas School for the Deaf. The Board may transfer positions, funds 13 14 and appropriations to the paying account from either school to serve both 15 schools in the areas of Accounting, Personnel, Inventory, Safety and Health
  - Funding and appropriations for this account will be from transfers from the fund accounts and appropriations of each agency and shall be divided proportionately from each agency based on student population. Said funds shall be payable from the joint account as if the positions and other budgetary line items of appropriation had originally been established in the joint account. Supervision of this account and supervision of the positions within may come from either school as determined by the Board of Trustees.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from <del>July 1, 2001</del> 25 <u>July 1, 2003</u> through <del>June 30, 2003</del> <u>June 30, 2005</u>.

BRAILLE AND LARGEPRINT TEXTBOOKS. The State Board of Education shall make reasonable rules and regulations to implement the Braille and Large Print Textbooks appropriation and is hereby authorized to negotiate directly with publishers of Braille and Large Print Textbooks for the purchase of such textbooks.

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- 18 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TEACHERS
- 20 FOR SENSORY IMPAIRED ENTERING STATE SERVICE. Upon the superintendent's
- 21 certification to the State Personnel Administrator of prior service at an
- 22 educational institution and most recent contractual salary, the salary of
- 23 teachers holding certification in teaching the visually impaired and entering
- 24 state service as teachers for the sensory impaired may be adjusted to a rate
- 25 of pay closest to but not less than their most recent annual salary.

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- 29 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 31 SALARY INCREASE. In the event that an act is enacted in which the public
- 32 schools receive funds from the General Assembly to raise the salaries of
- 33 teachers employed in the public school districts, the Arkansas School for the
- 34 Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind shall be included.
- 35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003

1	SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
2	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
3	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
4	restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
5	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
7	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
9	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
10	
11	SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
12	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
13	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
14	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
15	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
16	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
17	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
18	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
19	
20	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
21	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
22	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
23	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
24	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
25	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
26	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
27	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
28	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
29	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
30	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
