- 4 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
- 5 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
- 6 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 7 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
- 8 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court
- 9 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- 10 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
- ll established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be
- 12 requested as a new position(s) in the agencies biennial budget request.
- 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July

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- 16 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME
- 18 FACULTY. Riverside Vocational Technical School and the Technical Institutes
- 19 are not required to remit a state contribution to the state employee
- 20 insurance trust fund on Workforce Education Part-time Faculty Positions
- 21 unless the position will be utilized for more than 1,000 hours a year.
- 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
- 23 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

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- 25 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 28 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 35 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
2	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
3	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
4	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
5	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
6	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
7	
8	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
9	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
10	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
14	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
15	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
16	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
17	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
18	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
