9	SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS				
10	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY				
11	OPERATIONS - RECORD RETENTION. It is determined by the General Assembly of				
12	the State of Arkansas that immediate needs of TEA recipients must be met to				
13	enable that recipient to obtain and maintain work. In many instances these				
14	needs are not immediately met because of the original documentation				
15	requirements of the Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law. For this				
16	reason, the case management field staff of the Department of Human Services				
17	is authorized to approve up to \$500 per TEA client to be disbursed for				
18	employment needs of the client from accounts designated for that purpose.				
19	Further a facsimile copy of the client-completed form (DCO Form #1430 or				
20	successor) or a facsimile copy of a vendor's invoice is sufficient				
21	documentation for expenditure records. All original documentation shall be

36 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
- 2 OPERATIONS USE OF LOCAL FUNDS. To the extent allowed by Federal
- 3 requirements, including waiver, demonstration and pilot project options, the
- 4 Division of County Operations may use local and donated funds to obtain
- 5 federal matching funds to enhance federal agency programs.

- 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
- 8 through June 30, 2005.

- 10 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- ll by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 13 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 20 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 29 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
- 33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 36 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
2	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
