1 2 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - ELECTION POLL WORKERS TRAINING. There is hereby 3 appropriated, to the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be payable 4 from the State Central Services Fund, for training for Election Poll Workers 5 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following: 6 7 ITEM FISCAL YEARS 8 2003-2004 NO. 2004-2005 9 (01) POLL WORKER TRAINING \$ 150,000 \$ 150,000 10 11 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - NONPARTISAN JUDICIAL GENERAL ELECTIONS. There 12 is hereby appropriated, to the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be payable from the Judicial Filing Fee Fund, for covering the costs of election 13 14 expenses of the State Board of Election Commissioners for the biennial period 15 ending June 30, 2005, the sum of\$600,000. 16 17 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 18 19 FORWARD - ELECTION EXPENSES. At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002 June 30, 2004, any unexpended balance of monies provided for Election 20 21 Expenses, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same 22 purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. The 23 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 24 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 25 26 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF 28 ELECTION EXPENSES APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated for Election 29 Expenses may be used to cover the expenses of the State Board of Election 30 Commissioners and the county election commissions to conduct preferential primary elections, general primary elections, special primary elections, 31 32 nonpartisan judicial general elections, and statewide special elections. The 33 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July 1, 34 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 35

SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 3 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 19 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 22 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 25 26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
