22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
25 the State Board of Election Commissioners for the 2003-2005 biennium, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

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12 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - NONPARTISAN JUDICIAL GENERAL ELECTIONS. There
13 is hereby appropriated, to the State Board of Election Commissioners, to be
14 payable from the Judicial Filing Fee Fund, for covering the costs of election
15 expenses of the State Board of Election Commissioners for the biennial period
16 ending June 30, 2005, the sum of\$600,000.

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18 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
20 FORWARD - ELECTION EXPENSES. At the close of the fiscal year ending ~~June 30,~~
21 ~~2002~~ June 30, 2004, any unexpended balance of monies provided for Election
22 Expenses, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same
23 purpose for the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005. The
24 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1,
25 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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27 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
29 ELECTION EXPENSES APPROPRIATION. The funds appropriated for Election
30 Expenses may be used to cover the expenses of the State Board of Election
31 Commissioners and the county election commissions to conduct preferential
32 primary elections, general primary elections, special primary elections,
33 nonpartisan judicial general elections, and statewide special elections. The
34 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1,
35 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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1 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
4 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10
11 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
