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2 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 4 PROMOTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS. The Department of Arkansas Heritage is 5 hereby authorized to purchase from Maintenance and General Operations 6 appropriations provided by this Act, up to an amount not to exceed \$5,000 7 each fiscal year, promotional and educational merchandise, authorized by the 8 Director of the Department, to inform the public of the Department's 9 programs, to promote the functions of the Department, and to inform the 10 public regarding the services provided by the Department. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 12 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005. 13

SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 14 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NATURAL 16 AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL. The Director of the Department of Arkansas 17 Heritage shall be the disbursing officer for the appropriations provided by Sections 22 25 and 23 26 of this Act. Further, if grants are made to state 18 19 agencies from the appropriations provided by Sections 22 25 and 23 26 herein, the corresponding amount of appropriation and funding of such grant may be 20 21 transferred to such state agency for use in classifications of expenditures 22 as determined by conditions of the grant and the state agency.

23 In the event that such grants make it necessary to employ additional 24 personnel, the Department of Arkansas Heritage upon seeking prior review of 25 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee and approval of 26 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, may establish one or more new 27 additional positions at classifications and grades in conformance with the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (A.C.A. 22-5-201 et seq), but in 28 29 no event shall the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State authorize the 30 establishment of more than seven (7) regular new additional positions. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 7 PUBLICATION DEVELOPMENT AND RESALE. The Department of Arkansas Heritage is 8 hereby authorized to make fund transfers from the Natural & Cultural 9 Resources Historic Preservation Fund or other funds established from federal 10 or non-federal grants to the Publication Development and Resale Revolving 11 Fund to use to develop and purchase additional publications for resale after 12 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council. In no case shall the fund transfers exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in any 13 14 fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 15 1, 2001 July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.

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SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 18 19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 20 21 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

27

28 SECTION 34. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 29 30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

1	SECTION 35. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
7	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
8	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
9	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
10	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
11	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
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
