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15 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
17 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2002~~ June 30, 2004,
18 any unexpended appropriation and funds provided for in Professional Fees,
19 Capital Outlay, Mandatory Publications, Petition Verification, Publish Legal
20 Notices, Records Management, and Motor Voter System Operations/Maintenance/
21 Enhancement in Section 3 and for Professional Fees and Capital Outlay in
22 Section 6 herein, shall be carried forward and made available for the same
23 purposes for the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005. The
24 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1,
25 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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27 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
29 REIMBURSEMENT. The Miscellaneous Revolving Fund shall be reimbursed in the
30 manner provided by law. The provisions of this section shall be in effect
31 only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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33 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATE
35 CAPITOL POLICE. In the event that sufficient revenues, in the judgment of
36 the Secretary of State exist, the Secretary is hereby authorized to make

1 additional salary payments from such funds to those employees who have
 2 attained law enforcement certification above the basic certificate level, as
 3 defined by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards.

4 It is the intent of this Section that such payment shall be optional, at the
 5 discretion of the Secretary, dependent on sufficient revenues and shall not
 6 be implemented using funds specifically set aside for other programs within
 7 the Department.

8 Employees shall be eligible for all or a portion of additional salary
 9 payments scheduled as follows:

- 10 I. General Certificate - \$300 annually
- 11 II. Intermediate Certificate - \$600 annually
- 12 III. Advanced Certificate - \$900 annually
- 13 IV. Senior Certificate - \$1,200 annually

14 Payment of such funds may be made monthly, quarterly, semiannually or
 15 annually depending upon the availability of revenues and shall be restricted
 16 to the following classifications:

- 17 1. Sec. of State Capitol Police Chief
- 18 2. Sec. of State Police Sergeant
- 19 3. Sec. of State Corporal

20 Payments made under this Section which are awarded as partial or lump sum
 21 payments shall not be considered as salary for purposes of retirement
 22 benefits but shall be subject to withholding of all applicable federal and
 23 state taxes. Payments made under this Section shall not be construed as
 24 exceeding the maximum annual salary of the employee.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
 26 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

27
 28 SECTION 18. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 29 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 31 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
