22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
25 Employment Security Department for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
34 or its successor.

21 June 30, 2005. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from

24 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

26 FUNDS". Funds made available to the State under Section 903 of the Social
27 Security Act may be used, under the direction of the Employment Security
28 Department ~~with respect to federal fiscal year 1999, for the purpose of~~
29 ~~construction, and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of~~
30 ~~land and/or for the payment of salaries, related benefits and maintenance and~~
31 ~~operation of central and local office staff. Monies credited with respect to~~
32 federal fiscal years 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 ~~shall be used~~ solely for the
33 administration of the unemployment compensation program, for the purpose of
34 construction, and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of
35 land and/or for the payment of salaries, related benefits and maintenance and
36 operation of central and local office staff, or as otherwise prescribed in

1 Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended.

2 Funds received by the State on March 13, 2002 may be used as specified in
3 903(d) of the Social Security Act, for the purpose of construction, and
4 improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of land and/or for
5 the payment of salaries, related benefits and maintenance and operation of
6 central and local office staff, or as otherwise prescribed in Section 903 of
7 the Social Security Act, as amended.

8 The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by
9 which (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this
10 State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act exceeds (b) the
11 aggregate of the amounts used by this State and charged against the amounts
12 transferred to the account of this State.

18 ADDITIONAL POSITIONS. The Director of the Employment Security Department,
19 after receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after
20 seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the
21 authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may
22 become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet
23 Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are
24 financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons
25 may be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and
26 that the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the salary schedule
27 for comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of
28 this Act.

29 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
30 established herein during the next biennium, the position(s) must be

35 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY

1 FORWARD. Any balance in the General Revenue funds made available by this Act
2 as matching funds for the Welfare-to-Work Initiative which remains on ~~June~~
3 ~~30, 2002~~ June 30, 2004, may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, to
4 be used for the same purpose. The provisions of this section shall be in
5 effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~ July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30,
6 2005.

7
8 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING
10 FUNDS ALLOCATION. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after
11 review and recommendation from the state Workforce Investment Board and in
12 coordination with the Arkansas Transitional Employment Board, will allocate
13 the State General Revenue matching funds and other available welfare-to-work
14 funds, in accordance with welfare-to-work priorities set by the state and in
15 accordance with federal requirements. The Director, will implement an in-
16 depth program evaluation process of welfare-to-work activities and report
17 results to the Workforce Investment Board and the Transitional Employment
18 Board. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1,~~
19 ~~2001~~ July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

20
21 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
24 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30
31 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3
4 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
