22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
25 the Department of Parks and Tourism for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

18 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the  
 19 Department of Parks and Tourism - State Operations for the 2003-2005  
 20 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,  
 21 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
 22 purposes: seven hundred fifty four (754) temporary or part-time employees,  
 23 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 24 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 25 appropriate classification.

 14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

15 ~~ALLOCATION RESTRICTION. Of the amounts allocated in Section 4 hereof, it is~~  
 16 ~~the intent of the General Assembly that such amounts are to be the maximum~~  
 17 ~~expended in the applicable fiscal year from the funds as appropriated in~~  
 18 ~~Section 3 hereof for the benefit of the appropriate program so enumerated.~~  
 19 ~~Provided, however, that in the event that unforeseen circumstances occur in~~  
 20 ~~either fiscal year that would necessitate a transfer of the maximum~~

 14 SECTION 33. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

22  
 23 SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
