24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND THE ARCHEOLOGICAL  
27 SURVEY. There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas - Various  
28 Divisions and the Archeological Survey for the 2003-2005 biennium, the  
29 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
30 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
31 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
32 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
33 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
34 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
35 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
36 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-

27 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

29 PROVISION. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act the Chief Fiscal

30 Officer of the State, Treasurer of State and Auditor of State shall transfer

31 on their books the sum of Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$530,000)

32 from the Special State Assets Forfeiture Fund to the University of Arkansas

33 Fund for allocation to the Criminal Justice Institute. Of the total monies

34 transferred by this section, Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$230,000)

 30 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches,  
 31 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head  
 32 trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of  
 33 Arkansas, Fayetteville, the Board of Trustees may make special allowances  
 34 available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as  
 35 justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties  
 36 of said athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head

1 coaches, assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators,  
 2 and head trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the  
 3 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such  
 4 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary

 6 athletic event receipts, or from contributions from sources other than state

33 ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of

 36 contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such

1 amounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the

 14 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
 15 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
 16 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
 17 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
 18 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
 19 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
 20 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
 21 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
 22 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon

 32 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 35 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 36 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

1 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
2 with in disbursement of said funds.

4 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12  
13 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
15 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
