2	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - SOUTHERN LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE. There is
3	hereby appropriated, to the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative
4	Joint Auditing Committee, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund,
5	to assist in defraying the expenses of hosting the Southern Legislative
6	Conference, the sum of\$100,000.
7	
8	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
10	PROFESSIONAL FEES AND SERVICES RESTRICTION. Of the funds appropriated for
11	Professional Fees and Services, \$150,000 is restricted in each of the two
12	fiscal years for securing professional services, in areas of expertise other
13	than audit, for any special needs or requirements associated with any program
14	evaluations and/or special reports. Any unexpended balance of appropriations
15	which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002 June 30,
16	$\underline{2004}$ shall be transferred forward and made available for the year ending $\underline{\text{June}}$
17	30, 2003 June 30, 2005. Services contracted pursuant to this provision shall
18	only be secured upon approval of the Executive Committee of the Legislative
19	Joint Auditing Committee. The provisions of this section shall be in effect
20	only from <del>July 1, 2001</del> <u>July 1, 2003</u> through <del>June 30, 2003</del> <u>June 30, 2005</u> .
21	
22	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
23	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
24	PROVISION. Any unexpended balance of the appropriations of Regular Salaries,
25	Personal Services Matching or Maintenance and General Operations in Section 2
26	of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30,
27	2002 June 30, 2004 shall be transferred forward and made available for the
28	same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.
29	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 July
30	1, 2003 through June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005.
31	
32	SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
33	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 2004
34	SOUTHERN LEGISLATIVE CONFERENCE HOST COMMITTEE. The President Pro Tempore of
35	the Arkansas Senate and the Speaker of the Arkansas House of Representatives
36	are hereby authorized to designate an appropriate Host Committee consisting

1 of members of the Arkansas General Assembly to conduct advanced planning and 2 to conduct a program of activities for attendees of the 2004 Annual Meeting of the Southern Legislative Conference of the Council of State Governments to 3 4 be held in Arkansas. Upon authorization of the President Pro Tempore and the 5 Speaker of the House, the Legislative Auditor shall have a voucher prepared 6 and cause a warrant to be issued in the amount as appropriated in this Act 7 for expenses of planning and hosting the Southern Legislative Conference. 8 The Legislative Auditor shall deposit or invest the funds in an account or 9 accounts in a qualified financial institution or institutions located in the 10 State of Arkansas established solely for planning and hosting the Southern 11 Legislative Conference. The Host Committee shall have oversight responsibilities over the funds. The Legislative Auditor shall be custodian 12 13 of these funds, which shall be considered state governmental trust funds. 14 These funds are exempt from the provisions of the General Accounting and 15 Budgetary Procedures Law. Any funds remaining in the account after all 16 expenses for hosting the Southern Legislative Conference have been paid, not 17 exceeding the amount appropriated for hosting the Southern Legislative Conference, shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the 18 19 State Central Services Fund. 20 21 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 23 CONTINGENT POSITIONS. The Division of Legislative Audit is authorized to 24 establish five (5) contingent positions for use in the event that unforeseen 25 conditions arise that increase the audit responsibility of the Division 26 beyond available resources that necessitates the hiring of staff in addition 27 to those positions authorized in Section 1 of this Act. No classification, 28 grade or salary level will be assigned to the contingent positions until such 29 time as specific needs are determined. The Legislative Joint Auditing 30 Committee shall authorize all requests to use the contingent positions.

33 Joint Budget Committee. The provisions of this section shall be in effect

only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.

SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

Authorized requests to use the contingent positions shall be filed with the

Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for review by the Legislative Council or

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 2 PROVISION LINE ITEMS. The Legislative Auditor is hereby authorized to
- 3 <u>direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer appropriation</u>
- 4 between the line items of the appropriation in Section 2 of this Act in such
- 5 amounts determined necessary in either fiscal year of the 2003 2005
- 6 biennium. In no event, however, shall the Regular Salaries line item in
- 7 Section 2 be increased or decreased by such transfers authorized herein,
- 8 until the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee reviews such
- 9 transfers. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July
- 10 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.

- 12 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 14 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation and funding authorized
- 15 for the audit of the State of Arkansas' Comprehensive Annual Financial Report
- 16 (CAFR) in Section 3 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year
- 17 ending June 30, 2004 shall be carried forward and made available for the same
- 18 purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005. The provisions of this
- 19 section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2005.

- 21 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 24 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30

- 31 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1	testimony in the dilicial minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
3	
4	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
11	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
