21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §19-5-205 is amended to read as follows:  
24

25 19-5-205. Constitutional Officers Fund and State Central Services Fund.  
26

27 (a) The elected constitutional officers and their departments of  
28 government as established by the Constitution of the State of Arkansas and  
29 certain state departments and employees thereof are known and recognized as  
30 performing and rendering, either individually or collectively, services to  
31 every other state agency. The General Assembly declares that the services  
32 rendered are embraced under or by one (1) or more of the items or agencies as  
33 follows:

34 (1) Services rendered by the legislative, judicial, and  
35 executive departments of the state as recognized by the Constitution of the  
36 State of Arkansas;



1           (2) ~~Services rendered by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State~~  
2 ~~for management of the state's resources relating to general fiscal affairs,~~  
3 ~~administering the budget, accounting, purchasing, personnel, and other~~  
4 ~~applicable fiscal laws~~ agencies supporting the activities of the elected  
5 constitutional officers; and

6           (3) Those agencies supported from the State Central Services  
7 Fund, which collect the general revenue and special revenues as defined in  
8 the Revenue Classification Law of Arkansas, § 19-6-101 et seq., or such other  
9 laws as may be enacted by the General Assembly.

10          (b)(1) Those departments and activities of the state which perform the  
11 services as set out in subdivision (a)(1) of this section are declared to be  
12 the following:

13                   (A) The General Assembly, including State Capitol  
14 renovation of the General Assembly quarters, Senate and House of  
15 Representatives legislative session staff, interim expenses incurred by  
16 members of the Senate and House of Representatives, and the appropriations  
17 contained in the general appropriation bill made for services of the General  
18 Assembly;

19                   (B) Governor;

20                   (C) Lieutenant Governor;

21                   (D) Secretary of State;

22                   (E) Attorney General;

23                   (F) Treasurer of State;

24                   (G) Commissioner of State Lands;

25                   (H) Auditor of State;

26                   (I) Supreme Court;

27                   (J) Court of Appeals; and

28                   (K) Circuit and chancery courts and prosecuting attorneys.

29          (2) Those agencies and activities of the state which perform the  
30 services as set out in subdivisions (a)(2) and (3) of this section are  
31 declared to be the following:

32                   (A) Senate and House of Representatives interim staff;

33                   (B) The Bureau of Legislative Research, interim committee  
34 and interim committee study expenses of the Legislative Council;

35                   (C) The Division of Local Affairs and Audits of the  
36 Division of Legislative Audit and the Division of Legislative Audit of the

- 1 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee;
- 2 (D) Grants and contributions for the Commission on
- 3 Interstate Cooperation;
- 4 (E) Secretary of State;
- 5 (F) ~~Management Services and~~ Revenue Divisions of the
- 6 Department of Finance and Administration;
- 7 (G) Administrative Office of the Courts;
- 8 (H) Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator;
- 9 (I) Governor’s Mansion Commission;
- 10 (J) Arkansas State Claims Commission; and
- 11 (K) Other activities supporting the legislative, executive, and judicial
- 12 departments.

14 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

16 APPLICATION OF APPROPRIATIONS. Any appropriation for the biennial period

17 ending June 30, 2005 to the Department of Finance and Administration -

18 Management Services Division which is made payable from the State Central

19 Services Fund shall be payable from the State General Services Fund Account

20 in lieu thereof.
