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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Higher Education may provide loans,
24 from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund, in excess of the Southern Regional
25 Education Board grant funds to dental students enrolled in professional
26 programs outside the state, for whom any part of the out-of-state tuition is
27 paid by the State of Arkansas, if the tuition paid to the out-of-state
28 institution exceeds the Southern Regional Education Board contracted rate.

29 (b) The amount of the loans in excess of the Southern Regional
30 Education Board grant funds may be the amount of the out-of-state tuition
31 paid by the student, but the amount of the loan may not exceed the amount by
32 which the tuition exceeds the rate established by the Southern Regional
33 Education Board.

34 (c) The loans shall be made on an annual basis not to exceed the
35 combined total of four (4) years.

36 (d) The loans may be forgiven at the rate of one (1) year's loan for



1 one (1) year's practice in Arkansas.

2 (e) Repayment of the loan may be deferred, but for no longer than five
3 (5) years, for the following reasons:

4 (1) Military service;

5 (2) Specialty training; or

6 (3) Extraordinary circumstances as determined by the department.

7 (f) The loans shall be made at a rate of interest determined by the
8 department, but not to exceed four percent (4%).

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10 SECTION 2. The provisions of Section 1 shall not apply to Southern
11 Regional Education Board grant funds.
