9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - DIVISION OF CHILD  
12 CARE AND EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION FOR THE  
13 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND FOR  
14 OTHER PURPOSES.

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17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN  
18 SERVICES - DIVISION OF CHILD CARE AND  
19 EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPROPRIATION  
20 FOR THE 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.  
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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26 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES.* There is hereby established for the  
27 Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood  
28 Education for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of regular  
29 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
30 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or  
31 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
32 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
33 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
34 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
35 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
36 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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33 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 34 Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education for the  
 35 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
 36 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated

1 herein for such purposes: thirteen (13) temporary or part-time employees,  
 2 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 3 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 4 appropriate classification.

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6 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 7 the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood  
 8 Education, to be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief  
 9 Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of  
 10 the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood  
 11 Education for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

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5 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CHILD CARE GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,  
 6 to the Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early  
 7 Childhood Education, to be payable from the paying account as determined by  
 8 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grant payments of the Department  
 9 of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education for  
 10 the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

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18 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 19 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 20 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 21 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 35 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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1 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
2 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
3 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
4 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
5 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
6 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
7 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
8 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
9 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
10 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
11 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
