19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-26-1120 is amended to read as follows:
22 26-26-1120. Disabled persons.

23 (a) As used in Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 79, the term "disabled
24 person" means:

25 (1) a A person who is disabled for purposes of Title Subchapter
26 XIX of the federal Social Security Act as in effect on ~~January 1, 2001,~~
27 January 1, 2003, for any period during the calendar year;

28 (2) ~~or a~~ A person who is a permanently and totally disabled
29 veteran as defined by 38 C.F.R., Part IV, as in effect on ~~January 1, 2001,~~
30 January 1, 2003; or

31 (3) A person who has received permanent and total disability
32 insurance benefits for any period of time during the calendar year.

33 (b) (1) When a disabled person or a person sixty-five (65) years of age
34 or older sells his or her real property, the purchaser shall not be entitled
35 to claim any reduction to the property's assessed ~~value,~~ value.

36 (2) ~~and~~ On or after January 1 of the year following the date of



1 the sale, the county assessor shall assess the property at its full market
2 value, unadjusted for assessment limitations required by Arkansas
3 Constitution, Amendment 79.
