Funds 34 35 allocated under the appropriation for community-based services, for Grants to 36 Community Providers, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-

1 Aid appropriation in this act shall be used only to provide services through 2 private community based services licensed or certified by the Arkansas 3 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS). Non-profit community-4 based programs licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities 5 Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities of the state which provide 6 supports and services to individuals who have a developmental disability or 7 delay, who would otherwise require supports and services through state-8 operated programs and facilities owned by the State of Arkansas. When DDS 9 licensed providers are involved in delivering services which are Medicaid 10 reimbursable, they must enroll as a provider with the Arkansas Medicaid 11 Program and must bill the Arkansas Medicaid Program for all covered services 12 for eligible individuals.

Services which are covered by the Arkansas State Medicaid Program or under the Alternative Community Services Waiver Program (ACS) will be utilized to the maximum extent possible for any individual who is eligible for Medicaid coverage. It is the intent of this section that DDS, as a general policy, maximize the use of Medicaid funding available for appropriate services.

The State shall require each provider funded from this Appropriation for 18 19 community based services, including funding from the Grants/Patient Services Line, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Operations appropriation, 20 21 the Early Intervention Line, in the Developmental Disabilities Services -22 Operations appropriation, or from the Grants to Community Providers Line, in 23 the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation, to 24 screen each individual to whom services are provided for a determination of 25 eligibility or ineligibility for Medicaid coverage within thirty days of the 26 first date that services are provided. DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - TIMBER AND LAND SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL 27 28 IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities 29 Services is authorized to have cash fund accounts for capital improvements to 30 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment, and for the 31 operation of <u>for</u> the six human development centers operated by the Department 32 of Human Services, Division of Developmental Disabilities Services. The cash 33 funds shall be held by the Department of Human Services, Division of 34 Developmental Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of land and 35 the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services. The sale of land and the harvesting of 36

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1 timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to finance capital 2 improvements to the physical plants, for the purchase of major capital equipment, and for the operation of any and for major capital equipment 3 4 purchases at any of the six human development centers from which the land or 5 timber is sold. 6 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all 7 income derived from the sale of land and timber management to the Chief 8 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 36

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1	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
7	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
