21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
24 Department of Aeronautics for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics, to be payable from the Department of Aeronautics Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for grants to cities and counties by the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

1 SECTION 4. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 2 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES - DEPARTMENT
 3 OF AERONAUTICS FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act,
 4 the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in
 5 relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures
 6 would cause the Department of Aeronautics Fund to decline below four million
 7 two hundred ten thousand one hundred and six dollars (\$4,210,106) a fund
 8 balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available
 9 on July 1, 2001, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the
 10 executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under
 11 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with
 12 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the
 13 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to
 14 justify the expenditures and shall include the following:

- 15 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 16 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 17 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 18 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 19 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 20 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 21 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 22 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 23 depletion of the fund balance.

24 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
 25 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
 26 prior review by the Legislative Council.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
 28 through June 30, 2005.

 30 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 33 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

4 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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13 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
