The Executive Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission, with prior review of the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget 29 30 Committee, the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and for the reimbursing of documented expenditures designated by law to be made from the 31 transferred special revenue, may transfer funds among the Livestock and 32 33 Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special 34 35 Revenue Fund, Livestock and Poultry Commission Swine Testing Fund, and the Poultry and Egg Grading Fund or from these funds to the Livestock and Poultry 36

1 Fund Account. The purpose of these transfers shall only be for accurate 2 allocation of incurred costs between the funds. Requests for fund transfer will at least include the total amount to be transferred, to and from which 3 funds, the nature, purpose, and time period of the expenditures being 4 reimbursed, and any other information requested by the Legislative Council or 5 6 the Joint Budget Committee. 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 8 through June 30, 2005. 9 10 SECTION 30. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED 11 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES - LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY COMMISSION DISEASE AND PEST CONTROL FUND. 12 (A) For all 13 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 14 15 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the Livestock and Poultry 16 Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund to decline below two hundred forty 17 three thousand ninety six dollars (\$243,096) a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 18 19 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 20 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 21 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 22 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall 23 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall 24 include the following: 25 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 26 expenditures on the fund balance. 27 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut 28 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 29 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 30 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 31 32 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 33 depletion of the fund balance. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 34 (B) 35 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 36 prior review by the Legislative Council.

 <u>through June 30, 2005.</u>

SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 4 5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 7 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14 SECTION 32. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 19 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23 SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 31 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003. 34 35 */s/ Joint Budget Committee*
