SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STAFF SERVICES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Senate - Staff Services for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ORIENTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for the payment of per diem and mileage of members of the Arkansas Senate who attend the Biennial Senate Orientation program held prior to the convening of the 2005 Regular Session of the General Assembly, the sum of\$10,000.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION AND CARRYOVER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund or the State Central Services Fund, whichever is appropriate,

1 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2005, the balance of the 2 appropriations enacted by the Eighty-fourth General Assembly to defray the 3 expenses of the Arkansas Senate of the Eighty-fourth General Assembly, 4 Section 3 of Act 4 of 2001 and Sections 2, 4, 6 and 7 of Act 443 of 2001, in 5 a sum in the aggregate not to exceed\$4,016,908. 6 7 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTERIZATION. There is hereby appropriated, 8 to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, 9 for expenses necessary in continuing the computerization of the legislative 10 process in the Arkansas Senate, the sum of\$700,000. 11 12 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central 13 14 Services Fund, for construction, improvements, renovations and equipping of 15 the Arkansas Senate facilities and other purposes, the sum of......\$700,000. 16 17 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 18 19 FORWARD. Any balance remaining on June 30, 2002 June 30, 2004 in the 20 appropriation provided by Section 2 of this Act for Maintenance and General 21 Operations shall be carried forward and made available for the fiscal year 22 ending June 30, 2003 June 30, 2005 for the same purposes. 2.3 24 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 TRANSFERS. If the Senate Efficiency Committee and the Senate Fiscal Officer, 27 subject to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, should determine that any 28 item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not 29 needed for such purpose, the Senate Fiscal Officer may certify such fact to 30 the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made 31 from one item to another. 32 33 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENATE EMPLOYEES. The Senate Efficiency Committee may, at its discretion and 35 36 subject to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, employ, transfer or discharge

1 Arkansas Senate employees if it is determined by the committee to be in the 2 best interest of the Arkansas Senate. The actual salaries to be paid to 3 employees of the Arkansas Senate shall be determined by the Senate Efficiency 4 Committee within the funds, appropriations and maximum annual salaries as may 5 be available. 6 7 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 13 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 16 17 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 18 19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 20 21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25 26 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the 32 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.

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
