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3	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.	Disbursement of	funds authorized

22	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is foun	d and determine	d by the General				
23	Assembly, that funds provided by the Genera	l Assembly for	the operations of				
24	the Arkansas State Claims Commission are, d	ue to unforesee	n circumstances,				
25	insufficient for the Arkansas State Claims	Commission to c	ontinue to provide				
26	essential governmental services; that the p	rovisions of th	is act will provide				
27	the necessary monies for the Arkansas State	Claims Commiss	ion to continue				
28	such services; and that a delay in the effe	ctive date of t	his Act could work				
29	irreparable harm upon the proper administra	tion and provis	ion of essential				
30	governmental programs. Therefore, an emerge	ncy is hereby d	eclared to exist				
31	and this Act being necessary for the immedi	ate preservatio	n of the public				
32	peace, health and safety shall be in full f	orce and effect	from and after the				
33	date of its passage and approval. If the b	ill is neither	approved nor vetoed				
34	by the Governor, it shall become effective	on the expirati	on of the period of
