18 BIENNIUM.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
25 Code Revision Commission for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum
26 number of regular employees, the grades to be assigned to the respective
27 positions, and the maximum annual salaries for each such position. The
28 maximum annual salary for the position assigned to grades shall be determined
29 in accordance with, but shall not exceed the maximum annual amount for the
30 grade assigned herein, as established in Arkansas Code 21-5-209. Except for
31 the purpose of determining the maximum annual salary rate, which is to be
32 applicable to each of the positions to which a salary grade is assigned
33 hereinafter, in accordance with the provisions of Arkansas Code 21-5-209, all
34 positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions of the
35 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, but shall not
36 be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and



1 Restrictions Act, or its successor.

13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Code
 14 Revision Commission for the 2003-2005 biennium, the following maximum number
 15 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
 16 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: six (6) temporary or part-
 17 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in
 18 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this
 19 act for the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 22 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the State General
 23 Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 24 Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30,
 25 2005, the following:

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4 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - BUDGET SAVINGS. There is hereby appropriated,
5 to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from revenues
6 collected and transferred to the State General Services Fund Account to be
7 used exclusively by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission as set out in
8 Section 7 of this Act, for personal services and operating expenses of the
9 Arkansas Code Revision Commission, the sum of\$0.

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11 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
13 AUTHORITY. The Arkansas Code Revision Commission may transfer appropriation
14 and funds as needed from the Budget Savings Appropriation in Section 4 to any
15 line item in the Operations Appropriation in Section 3 of this Act.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
17 through June 30, 2005.

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19 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
21 OF ALLOCATION. Funds allocated for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission
22 from the State Administration of Justice Fund shall be transferred or
23 deposited into the ~~State Central Services Fund~~ State General Services Fund
24 Account to be used exclusively by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission ~~as~~
25 ~~direct revenue~~ for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, in lieu of transfer
26 or deposit for the Arkansas Code Revision Fund.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
28 through June 30, 2005.

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30 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUDGET
32 SAVINGS TRANSFER. (a) Due to savings from receiving free sets of the
33 Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated, each Agency or Officer shall transfer or

28 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
 29 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for
 30 the transfer or deposit of the funds from each Officer or Agency as listed
 31 herein to Section 4 of this Act ~~as direct revenue to the State Central~~
 32 ~~Services Fund~~ to the State General Services Fund Account to be used

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 36 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CODE
2 REVISION COMMISSION OVERSIGHT.

3 (a) The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, or a Bureau
4 employee designated by the Director, shall be the disbursing officer for the
5 funds appropriated by this act.

6 (b) The Director, or a Bureau employee designated by the Director, shall
7 maintain all personnel records of the Commission.

8 (c) When the Director contracts for an audit of the Bureau, he or she
9 shall include in the contract a financial audit of the commission with a
10 proportional cost to be borne by the Commission except that the Bureau shall
11 bear the cost in excess of funds available to the Commission for that
12 purpose.

13 (d) By September 1st of each year, the Director, or a Bureau employee
14 designated by the Director, shall evaluate the staff of the Code Revision
15 Commission, reporting any problems to the Code Revision Commission.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~
17 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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19 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
20 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
21 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
22 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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29 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
36 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
