9 AN ACT TO RAISE THE FEES FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF  
10 DRIVER'S LICENSES SUSPENDED FOR DWI AND REFUSAL  
11 TO SUBMIT, FOR DUPLICATE LICENSES, AND FOR  
12 SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE;  
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT TO RAISE THE FEES FOR THE  
17 REINSTATEMENT OF DRIVER'S LICENSES  
18 SUSPENDED FOR DWI AND REFUSAL TO SUBMIT,  
19 FOR DUPLICATE LICENSES, AND FOR SERVICES  
20 PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE OF MOTOR VEHICLE.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-119 is amended to read as follows:  
26 5-65-119. Distribution of fee.

27 The Office of Driver Services of the Revenue Division of the Department  
28 of Finance and Administration shall charge a fee of ~~seventy-five dollars~~  
29 ~~(\$75.00)~~ one-hundred-fifty dollars (\$150.00) for reinstating a driving  
30 privilege suspended or revoked because of an arrest for operating or being in  
31 actual physical control of a motor vehicle while intoxicated or while there  
32 was an alcohol concentration of eight-hundredths (0.08) or more in the  
33 person's breath or blood, § 5-65-103, or refusing to submit to a chemical  
34 test of blood, breath, or urine for the purpose of determining the alcohol or  
35 controlled substance contents of the person's blood or breath, § 5-65-202,  
36 which shall be distributed as follows:



1           (1) ~~Fourteen percent (14%)~~ Seven percent (7%) of the revenues  
2 derived from this fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury as special  
3 revenues and credited to the Public Health Fund to be used exclusively for  
4 the Office of Alcohol Testing of the Department of Health;

5           (2) ~~Sixty-six percent (66%)~~ Thirty-three percent (33%) of the  
6 revenues derived from this fee shall be deposited as special revenues in the  
7 State Treasury into the Constitutional Officers Fund and the State Central  
8 Services Fund as a direct revenue to be used by the Office of Driver Services  
9 for use in supporting the administrative driver’s licensing revocation and  
10 sanctions programs provided for in this subchapter; ~~and~~

11           (3) ~~Twenty percent (20%)~~ Ten percent (10%) of the revenues  
12 derived from this fee shall be deposited in the State Treasury, and the  
13 Treasurer of State shall credit them as general revenues to the various funds  
14 in the respective amounts to each and to be used for the purposes as provided  
15 in the Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.; and

16           (4) Fifty percent (50%) of the revenues derived from the fee  
17 levied by this section shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit  
18 of the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund, there to  
19 be distributed with the other gross general revenue collections for that  
20 month in accordance with the Revenue Stabilization Law.

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22           SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-16-806(c), pertaining to fees for  
23 replacement driver’s licenses, is amended to read as follows:

24           (c) In addition to the fee imposed in subsection (a) of this section,  
25 an additional fee of five dollars (\$5.00) shall be collected and deposited in  
26 the State Treasury to the credit of the General Revenue Fund Account of the  
27 State Apportionment Fund, there to be distributed with the other gross  
28 general revenue collections for that month in accordance with the Revenue  
29 Stabilization Law.
