25	SECTION 1. (a)	The purpose of this section is to pr	omote uniformit	<u> </u>
26	in the regulation of	ground transportation services in coun	ties having a	
27	population of at leas	et two hundred fifty thousand (250,000)	persons.	
28	(b) The follow	ring definitions shall apply to any mun	icipal ordinanc	<u>:e</u>

32	<u>(1)(A) "</u>	Airport shuttle vehicle" means a motor	vehicle with a	ī

35	<u>(B)</u>	"Airport Shuttle vehicle" is subject	to the followi	ng
36	operational requireme	ents:		

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1	(i) Twenty-four (24) hour minimum pre-arranged trip;	
2	(ii) Operation on fixed routes with either the origination point	
3	or termination point being Little Rock Regional Airport;	
4	(iii) Charges a fixed per passenger rate; and	
5	(iv) Does not include an executive sedan.	
6	(C) The vehicle shall prominently display "Shuttle	
7	Service" on the front or rear sides of the vehicle. This marking may be	
8	permanent or temporary;	
9	(2) "Airport terminal service" means the provision of public	
10	transportation service operated for the purpose of transporting passengers	
11	exclusively to and from a national airport terminal building and adjacent	
12	parking facilities;	
13	(3) "Black car" has the same meaning as executive sedan;	
14	(4) "Courtesy vehicle" means any motor vehicle operating upon	
15	the public streets of the city and that is owned or leased by a public or	
16	private entity and operated exclusively to provide transportation services to	
17	patrons to and from the entity's place of business without charge or other

19	(5)(A) "Demand-response service" means the provision of a "for-

24	(B) "Demand-response service" is a response to any call	
25	that has not been pre-scheduled at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of	
26	the pick-up time;	
27	(6) "Taxicab driver" means a person licensed by the state who	
28	has registered as a taxicab driver with the city and has obtained a taxicab	
29	driver's permit as required by the city, and who has been permitted to drive	
30	a taxicab by an operator, or has entered into a written agreement for use of	
31	a taxicab with an operator;	
32	(7) "Exclusive ride" means a ride in which the passenger	
33	engaging the taxicab restricts the ride solely to the passenger, or the	
34	passenger's party, and the fare is charged at the ceiling rate;	
35	(8)(A) "Executive sedan" means a taxicab that is:	
36	(i) A sedan-type motor vehicle equipped with a	

1	taximeter and having a seating capacity not in excess of six (6) passengers	
2	including the driver;	
3	(ii) Used for the transportation of persons for	
4	<pre>hire;</pre>	
5	(iii) Recognized by the automobile industry as a	
6	<pre>luxury vehicle;</pre>	
7	(iv) Operated at premium taxicab meter rates; and	
8	(v) A vehicle that is two (2) model years old or	
9	$\underline{\text{newer}}$ when initially inspected by the city or its designee to be placed into	
10	service.	
11	(B) Executive sedan, black car, livery vehicle, or premium	
12	taxicab shall be deemed to be demand-response service vehicles;	
13	(9) "Fleet taxicab operator" means a person operating two (2) or	
14	more taxicabs, executive sedans, black cars, livery vehicles, or premium	
15	taxicabs;	
16	(10) "Independent taxicab operator" means any person permitted	
17	by the city to operate a single taxicab;	
18	(11) "Livery vehicle" has the same meaning as executive sedan;	
19	(12) "Luxury limousine" means any of the following unmarked,	
20	large, and luxurious passenger vehicles driven by a chauffeur and being of a	
21	class and condition commonly associated with luxury markets:	
22	(A) A luxury sedan-type motor vehicle that:	
23	(i) Has a wheelbase of not less than one hundred	
24	twenty-five (125) inches and having a partition between the driver and	
25	passenger compartment; and	
26	(ii) Is two (2) model years old or newer when	
27	initially inspected by the city or its designee to be placed into service; or	
28	(B) A customized luxury full size van-type motor vehicle	
29	that:	
30	(i) Has a wheelbase of not less than one hundred	
31	twenty-five (125) inches, luxury interior, and luxury seating for seven (7)	
32	or more passengers including the driver;	
33	(ii) Is two (2) model years old or newer when	
34	initially inspected by the city or its designee to be placed into service;	
35	(13) "Manifest" means a daily record prepared by the taxicab	
36	operator of all trips made by each taxicab showing the time and place of	

1	origin of a call, time the call was dispatched, and to what driver, and when	
2	possible, the address at which the passenger was dropped off;	
3	(14) "Operator" means the holder of a valid permit for the	
4	operation of taxicabs, black cars, executive sedans, livery vehicles or	
5	premium taxicabs in the city;	
6	(15) "Passenger-for-hire" means a person who engages a ride in a	
7	taxicab, or other "for-hire" vehicle;	
8	(16) "Permittee" means the person, firm or corporation holding	
9	the operator or driver permit issued by the city;	
10	(17) "Person" means an individual, firm, partnership,	
11	association, joint venture, organization, and bodies politic and corporate,	
12	or any combination thereof;	
13	(18) "Premium taxicab" has the same meaning as executive sedan;	
14	(19) "Public transit system" means a passenger transportation	
15	service operated for the general public at a prescribed fare along	
16	established routes on a fixed schedule, and other special routes and services

26	vehicle, airport shuttle, or airport transit service;	
27	(B) Designed for seven (7) passengers or more, including

29	(C) Clearly marked with the company name, address,	
30	telephone number, and type of service provided;	
31	(22) "Special paratransit vehicle" means any motor vehicle:	
32	(A) Operated exclusively by its owner, or employee of the	
33	owner, as a passenger carrier "for-hire" over the public streets of the city,	
34	other than a public transit bus, taxicab, luxury limousine, courtesy vehicle,	
35	airport shuttle, or scheduled medical transport vehicle;	
36	(B) Designed for seven (7) passengers or more, including	

1	the driver, except when the vehicle has been modified to meet the		
2	accessibility standards of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; and		
3	(C) Clearly marked with the company name, address,		
4	telephone number, and type of service provided;		
5	(23) "Specialized transportation service" means any		
6	transportation of passengers upon the public streets of the city by motor		
7	vehicle;		
8	(24) "Specialty transportation" means the transportation of		
9	passengers "for-hire" upon the public streets of the city by any vehicle		
10	which is drawn by horse, mule or other animal, or any other novelty-type		
11	vehicle which is not otherwise defined by this section;		
12	(25) "Taxi zone" means that curb space along the public streets		
13	of the city designated for the exclusive parking of taxicabs by the proper		
14	placement of signs or markers reading "No Parking, Taxi Zone";		
15	(26)(A) "Taxicab" means motor vehicles clearly marked as such,		
16	equipped with a taximeter and having a seating capacity not in excess of		
17	seven (7) passengers and used for the transportation of persons "for-hire".		
18	(B) A Taxicab shall be five (5) model years old or newer		
19	when initially inspected by the city or its designee to be placed into		
20	service.		
21	(C) "Taxicab" shall not include a vehicle having a seating		
22	capacity in excess of seven (7) passengers and employed in transporting		
23	persons over regular routes having fixed terminals or upon regular schedule

25	(D) "Taxicab" may include motor vehicles designed for		
26	fifteen (15) passengers or less, including the driver, which have been		
27	modified to meet the accessibility requirements and standards of the		
28	Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. However, the vehicle so modified		
29	shall not have a seating capacity in excess of seven (7) passengers.		
30	(E) "Taxicab" includes black cars, executive sedans,

32	(27) "Taxicab service" means a passenger transportation service		
33	operated in a vehicle permitted by the city and not operating on a fixed

35	(28) "Tour vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:		
36	(A) Has a wheelbase of not less than one hundred twenty-

2	(B) Is two (2) model years old or newer when initially
3	inspected by the city or its designee to be placed into service;

5	(D) Has a seating capacity of at least eight (8) and not
