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21	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS. There i	s hereby

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29	SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded	nor

Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 2 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 3 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 4 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act. 5 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing 6 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 7 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State 8 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, 9 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law. 10 11 12 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 13 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 14 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 15 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 16 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 18 19 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20 21 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 23 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or 24 25 enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the 26 adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire, 27 the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the 28 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects. 29 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the 32 33 Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time 34 during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the
